***"SCIENCE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH IN EMERGENCIES"***

(May 20, 2025, Kyiv)

We, the participants of the round table "***Science for Public Health in Emergency Situations***", held on May 20, 2025 at the State Institution «Marzieiev Institute for Public Health of the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine», the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of Ukraine, the Ministry of Health of Ukraine, research institutions, professional public associations, with a total number of..... people

***...by considering such programmatic issues:***

- academic science in emergency situations;
- implementation of scientific developments in emergency situations and martial law;
- open science to address public health issues in emergencies;
- regulation of healthcare professions in the context of preparation for EU accession.

***...guided*** by the Decree of the President of Ukraine "On the Decision of the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine of May 14, 2021 "On the Human Development Strategy" No. 255/2021 and the "Healthcare System Development Strategy until 2030" developed pursuant to the said Decree and the "Operational Plan for the Implementation of the Healthcare System Development Strategy until 2030 in 2023", the Law of Ukraine "On the Public Health System", the Association Agreement between Ukraine, on the one hand, and the European Union, the European Atomic Energy Community and their Member States, on the other hand...

***...aligning tactical approaches*** to solving problems with operational goals:

2.3. "Ensuring intersectoral cooperation to ensure a nationwide approach to healthcare issues",

2.4. "Ensuring that European integration aspirations and the global agenda are taken into account in the formulation and implementation of healthcare policies",

2.5. "Ensure that appropriate evidence, planning tools, best practices and solutions are used and institutionalized to ensure consistency and harmonization of health system development."

2.6. "Strengthening the capacity of the health care system to respond to challenges, global threats and effective management in emergency situations",

3.1 "Ensuring continuous development of human capital and creating opportunities for self-realization in the healthcare system",

#### MADE A DECISION:

1. **To approve** the main points of the reports heard.
2. **Establish the priority of** implementing scientific developments for public health in emergencies in Ukraine and regulating health professions in the context of preparation for EU accession.
3. **To positively evaluate** the work of the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine and the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of Ukraine in providing scientific support to the population of Ukraine in the current crisis conditions.
4. To create conditions for more active exchange of experience in helping the population of Ukraine in unstable conditions between the institutions of the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine and the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine.
5. Continue to develop and implement methodological recommendations for training specialists to work in crisis conditions in scientific, educational and practical areas.
6. Conduct joint scientific research on psychological and medical factors of preserving the mental health of the Ukrainian population in times of war.
7. Recognize the need to ensure that state regulation of professional qualifications in the healthcare sector is in line with the EU legislation.

Agree in principle with the regulatory proposals presented at the roundtable as being in line with the basic principles of EU law and policy.

The participants of the Roundtable emphasize the critical importance of consolidating efforts to ensure constructive behavior and preserve the health of the Ukrainian population in the face of unprecedented wartime challenges.
